Your Passenger Manifest Bring your **FLIGHT ITINERARY** with you, along with the **PASSENGER MANIFEST** that is enclosed with your Travel Document Pouch. Locate your name on the **PASSENGER MANIFEST** and make sure that your name matches **EXACTLY** as your name indicated on your passport. Notify our office immediately if your name does not match exactly. You are traveling as a group member and as such, must present these documents upon check-in at the airport ticketing desk in order to receive your boarding pass. Keep this information with you throughout your tour. The **FLIGHT ITINERARY** and the **PASSENGER MANIFEST** are documents that verify your identity; these documents associate you with the ticket being held in your name with a distinct passenger ticket identification number. The **PASSENGER MANIFEST** contains your ticket number that you will need in case of a travel emergency the day of travel or to help the airlines find your reservation.

Take a look at your name as it appears on the Passenger Manifest. Make sure your name matches EXACTLY as your name indicated on your passport. Notify us immediately if your name does not match exactly.

Plan to arrive at the Turkish Airlines ticket counter no later than 5:40p for check-in.



Make copies to carry with you and leave at home with family and friends

- Passport
- Passenger manifest
- Travel insurance policy
- Letter verifying your travel insurance covers Covid-19 and/or its variants including coverage for quarantine
- List of your medications and dosage
- CDC vaccination card
- Participant Pre-Departure Package for easy reference

For your electronics, compatible with Israel system



What is not included?

- Travel Insurance
- Purchases of a personal nature
- Hotel wi-fi
- Hotel minibars
- Lunches other than those mentioned
- Any meals and beverages not mentioned
- Spa facilities, services, hotel amenities requiring arrangements made in advance
- Love offering to the tour guide and bus driver



What is not included?

TRAVEL INSURANCE

All foreign visitors traveling to Israel are mandated to show proof of their having purchased travel insurance that includes coverage for Covid-19 and/or its variants and coverage for quarantine. Please ensure that you have purchased travel insurance that satisfies the mandated Government of Israel Entry Protocol. You will not be permitted into the country if you do not comply with their protocol. Additional information is found in the Participant Pre-Departure Package.

For group members participating in the optional Turkey Pre-trip, please complete the online visa prior to your departure from the US.

I have a few questions:

Do I need a **visa**? No. US citizens do not require a visa.

Can I bring my **laptop**? **ipad**? Yes, and bring necessary cables for your gadgets.

Cellphone? Check with your cellphone provider for service in Israel.

Can I use my **credit card** in Israel? Yes. Ask your credit card company if they charge for overseas transaction fees. You may want to check with credit card companies that do not charge transaction fees. Advise your credit card company in advance that you will be traveling overseas and plan to use your card overseas, otherwise they might block activity on your credit card while you're away.

What about **camera equipment**? Can I bring it? Yes. It's up to you. Most cellphones do take great pictures, though.

What's the **electrical current** in Israel? 220 volts AC

Bring an adapter - If you're plugging in an appliance that was built for 220 volt **electrical** input, or an appliance that is compatible with multiple voltages, then an adapter is all you need.



Gentle Reminders

Mantra: Casual, Comfortable, Respectful Israel is a Mediterranean country, comfy and casual.

Modest dress for religious sites.

Most importantly: comfortable walking shoes

Remember to bring your Bible... time for reflection, sharing devotionals, reciting scripture.

They want to make sure that you and the other passengers are safe. Please be courteous, polite, and patient. 


Your Bible is very important; please bring it with you. Your Bible becomes your best guide, from now on and forever.

Your Passenger Guest Gift Package Items

- If you leave anything in your hotel safe, remember to check the safe before you check out of the hotel each time.
- Liquids are not permitted in the airplane cabin beyond a certain quantity in a specific bottle size; check Turkish Airlines' website for specific information in this regard.






Packing Tip
